## ABOUT THE COLLEGE

On the 4th of August 1968, we started our journey of emancipation of knowledge as Krishnagar College of Commerce to address the people's ardent necessity and interest in Commerce Education. Back in those days, the new-born college arranged all its classes at the premises of Debnath High School. After a year the classrooms shifted to Krishnagar Anglo Vernacular High School till 1970 when the College acquired its place at the current location of its presence. As

it started growing with time, it began to embrace multiple disciplines into its arena of courses. It was in 1993 that Krishnagar College of Commerce came with the new name of Dwijendralal College as a tribute to the great poet and freedom- fighter of the land Sri



Dwijendralal Roy and also as an obvert hint to its expanding interest in diversification following the path of the versatile legend with which it is eponymously connected. Thus in 2003, a diversification of the institution took place with the expansion of curricular and pedagogical emphasis to disciplines of Humanities along with Commerce Education.

Today the college extends over two campuses in the city of Krishnagar with undergraduate and postgraduate courses on various disciplines of Humanities and Commerce and is recognized under section 2(f) and included under section 12 (B) of UGC Act 1956, vide letter number UGC/3511-52L-8 dated 31/03/1993. In the initial stage, the college was affiliated with the University of Calcutta and now holds an affiliation with the University of Kalyani since 1999. The college that once started to impart knowledge in lighted classrooms amidst the dark of night now shines day-bright with its NAAC accredited version and RUSA backed infrastructural, teaching-learning facilities.

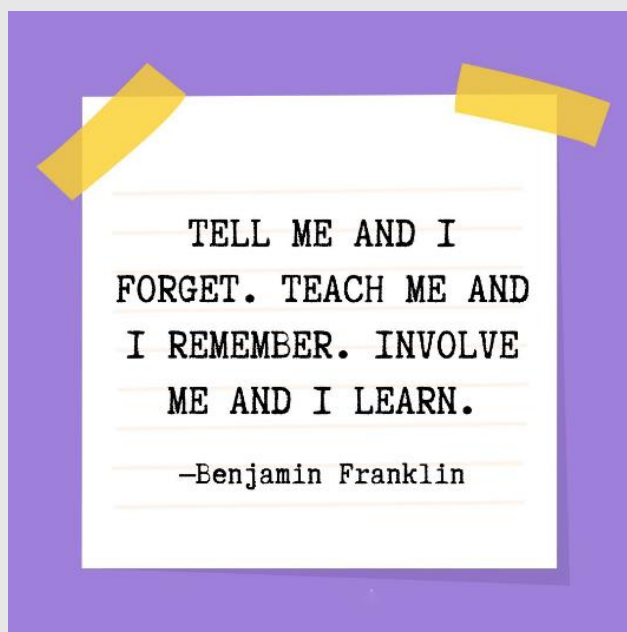
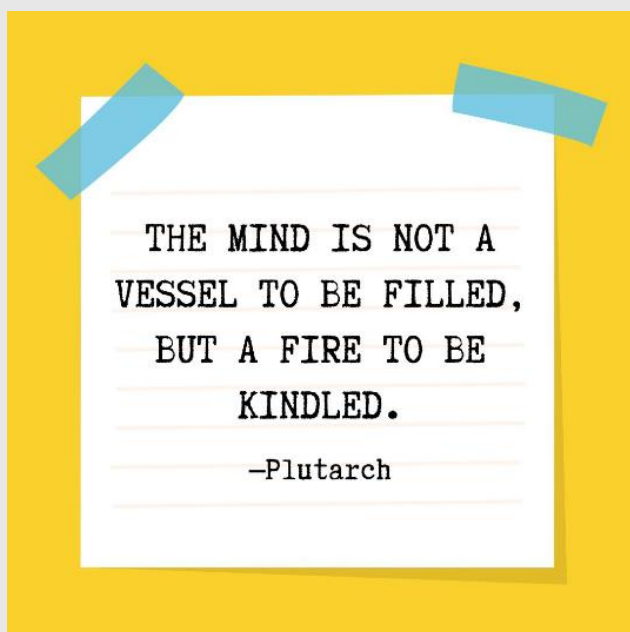
- implementing an online payment system for fees has been proven to be is a convenient and beneficial for the students.

# THE CENTRAL LIBRARY



## ◆ GENERAL INFORMATION

The college library is well stocked with over 31,000 books plus journals. The library is automated with Integrated library Management System (ILMS). It also gives a wide access of online e-books and e-journals by N-list to the students. The students are allowed to make use of all sorts of e-resources with no additional charges. The library has total 3 dedicated rooms for its academic resources. It also has a reading room for the students with a seating capacity of 50 students at a time. There has digitised cataloguing system for searching the library books. Students are allowed to get access of internet facility at the library. Students also get the benefit of various journals and periodicals kept for different competitive examinations. The students are also entitled to procure photocopies of important books only from the library.

## ◆ LIBRARY WORKING HOURS

10 a.m. to 4 p.m. (Monday to Saturday)

## ◆ LIBRARY RULES & REGULATIONS

- ✓ Students of every class need to deposit their requisition slips for getting their books.
- ✓ Students are advised to search books using the Web OPAC.
- ✓ As per the requisition slips the books are issued.
- ✓ For taking the books with the deposit of requisition slips, the students need to come in person.
- ✓ Library books are to be refunded to the library by 1.15 pm.



- ✓ Reading room can be used within the library hours showing the reading Room card, books issued for use in the Reading Room cannot be taken away from the library & can be used for xerox purpose in the college xerox machine only.
- ✓ Books issued to the students require to be refunded within 30 days from the date of issue and this can be extended up to the next 30 days only after renewal and a fine of 50 paise per day is charged to them for books holding beyond those scheduled days.
- ✓ Students requiring books after receiving admit cards for university exams may withdraw refundable maximum 3 books for Hons subjects and 2 books for general students from the library.
- ✓ Students losing and damaging the books issued to them must substitute the same with new books only.

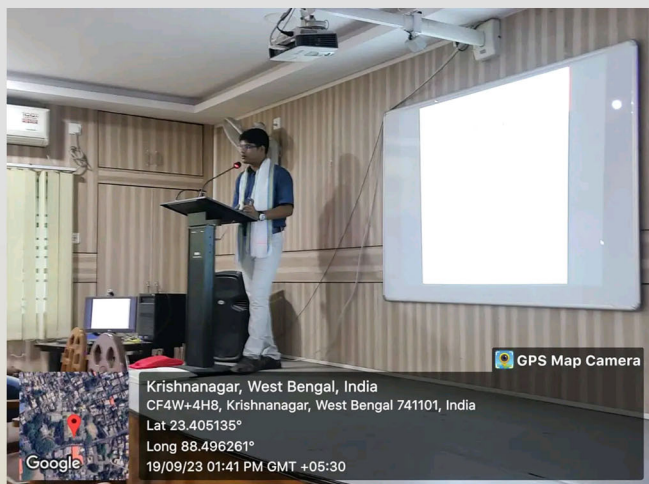

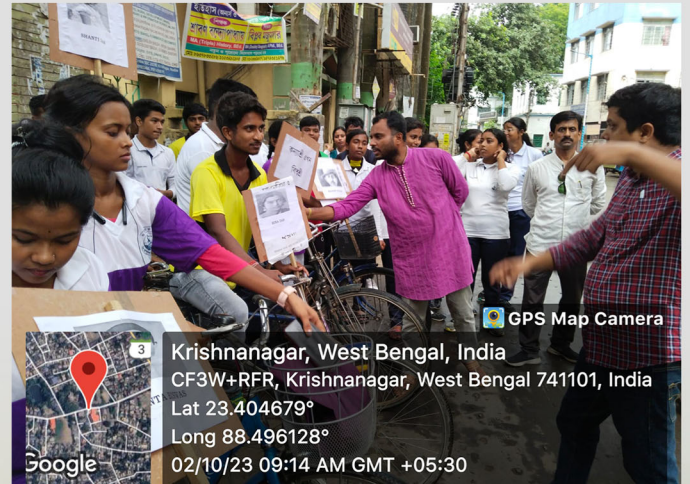

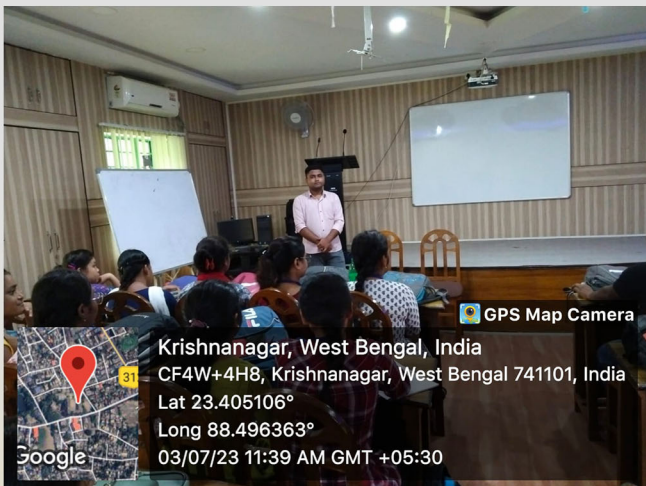
