## 3. INTRODUCTION OF NATIONAL CADET CORPS (NCC):

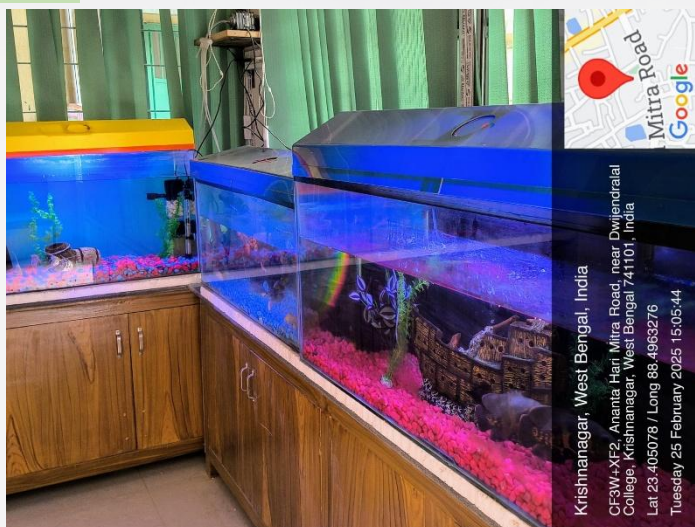

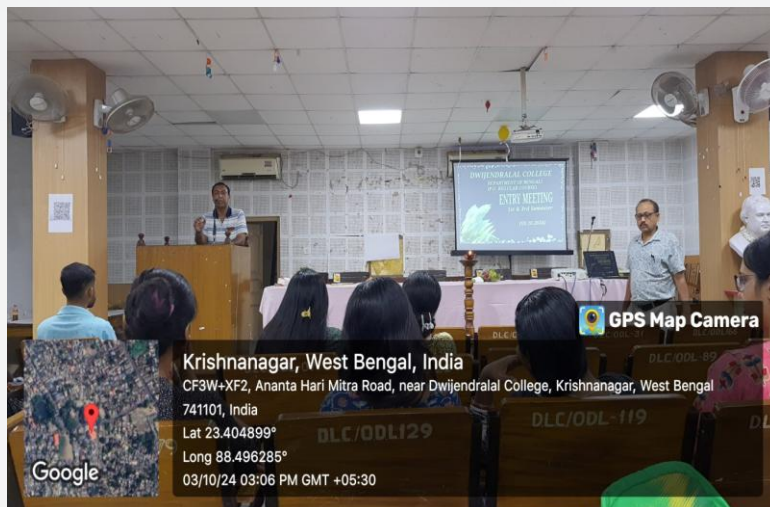


## DEPARTMENTAL EVENTS AND ACTIVITIES

The Entry Meeting for 3rd Semester students was conducted on November 26, 2024. The session formally welcomed students, introducing them to the academic framework and expectations for the

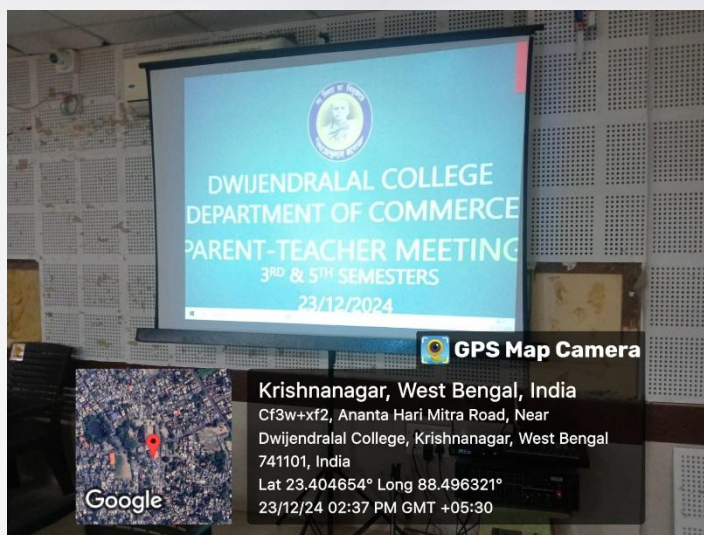




### DECEMBER 23, 2024: PARENT-TEACHER MEETING - 3RD & 5TH SEMESTER:

aimed to enhance students' research and academic writing skills, equipping them with essential methodologies for structuring and presenting research projects effectively.

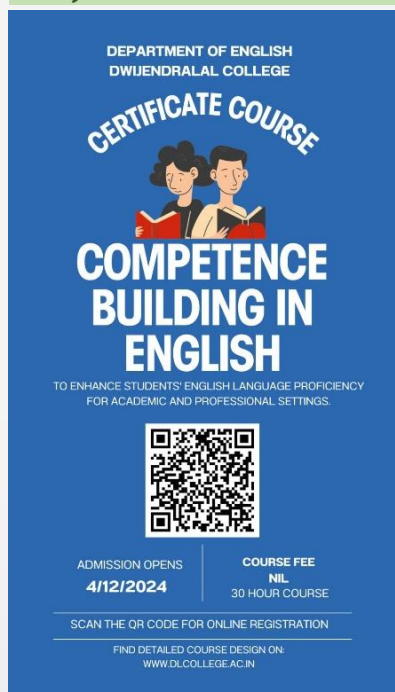


## DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH

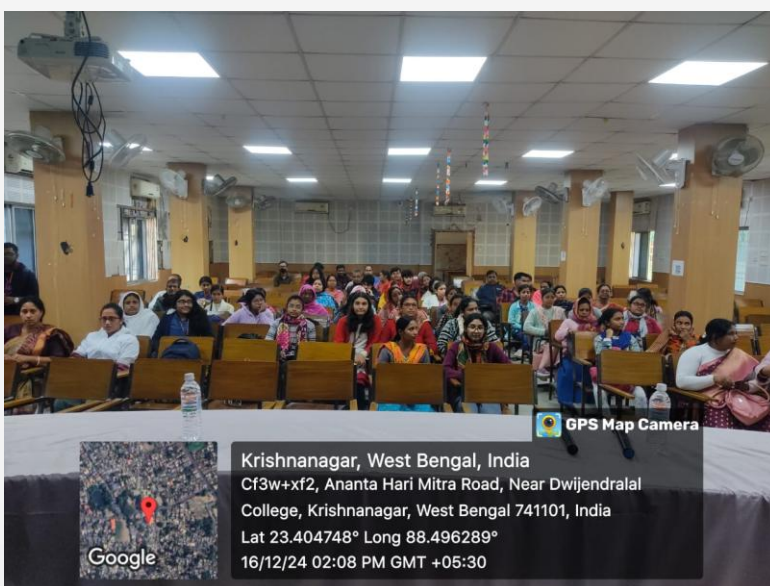
by students of 3rd semesters. The magazine aims to encourage creativity, literary expression, and intellectual exchange among students, providing them with a platform to present their work to a wider audience.

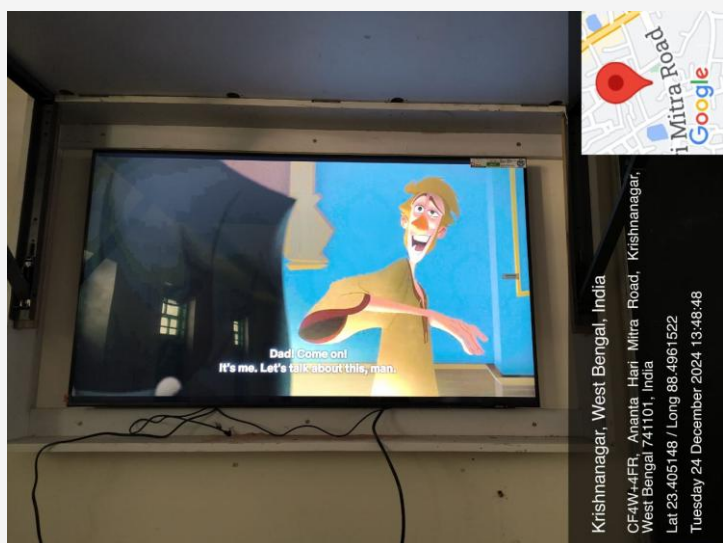

- Announcement of Mid-Semester/Internal Examination Date/Week, ensuring students are well-prepared for assessments.

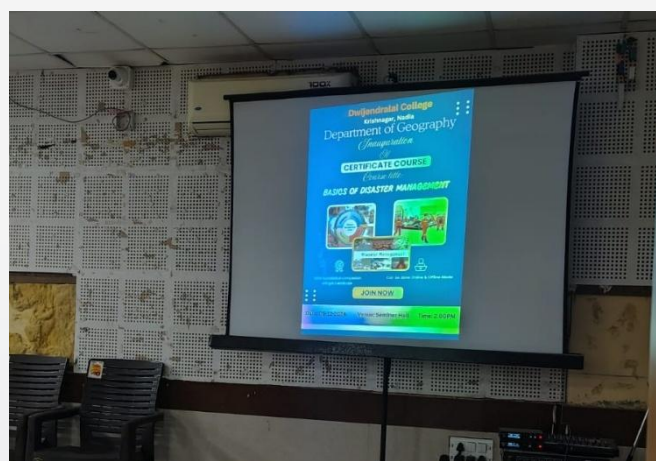

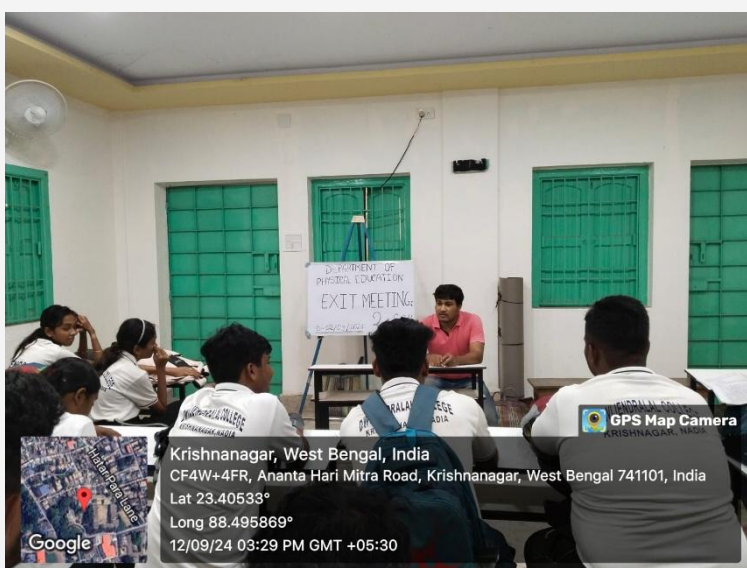

#### **OCTOBER 4, 2024: ENTRY MEETING FOR 5TH SEMESTER:**

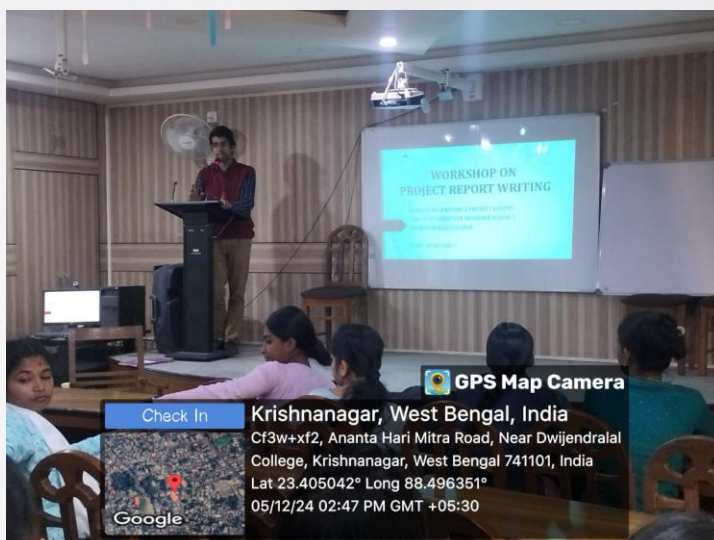

services. Students from various departments participated actively, reflecting the growing

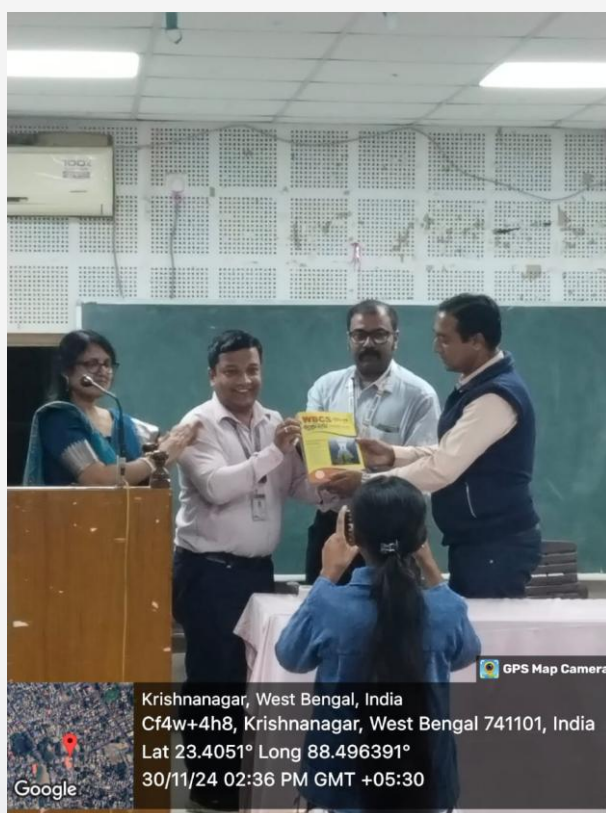
interest in industry-aligned skill development. The seminar encouraged students to explore emerging career paths and understand current industry requirements.
