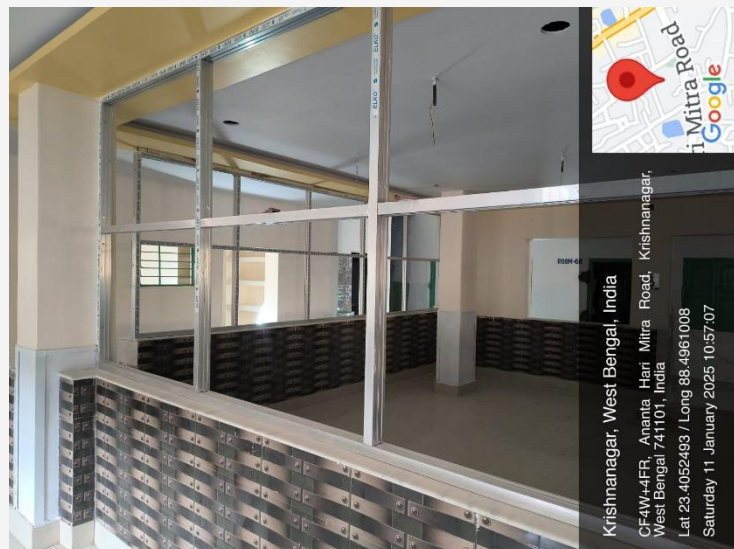
## FIRE EXTINGUISHERS INSTALLATION:

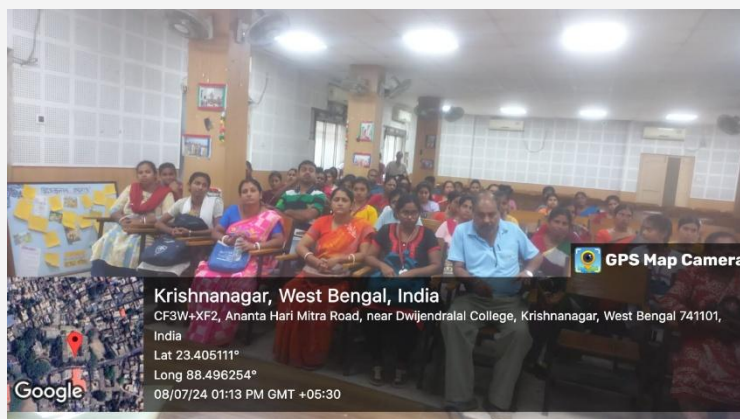


Students of Visva-Bharati performed a dance drama based on Raktokarabi.

## DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE

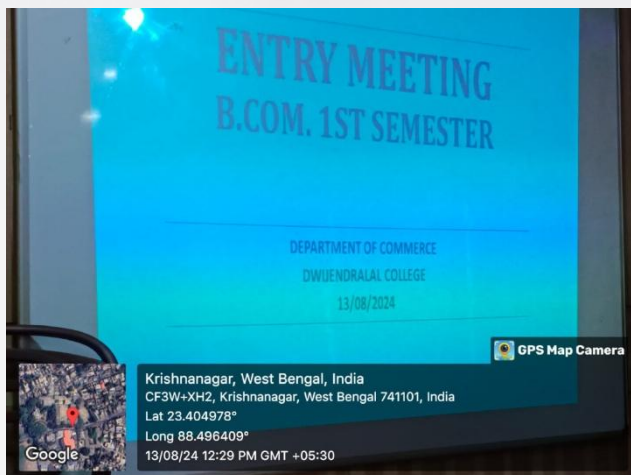

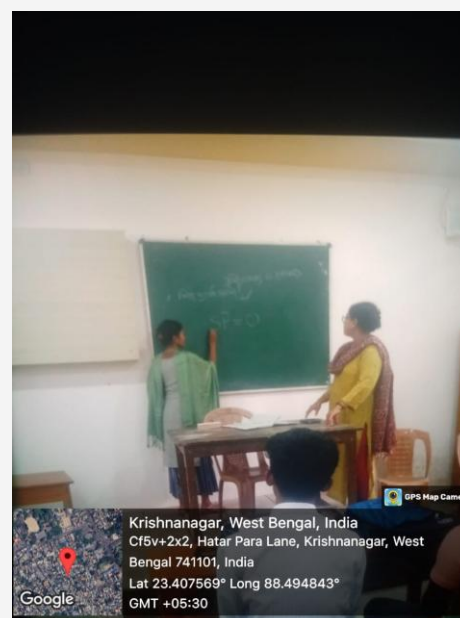
**09/08/2024:** An Entry Meeting was arranged

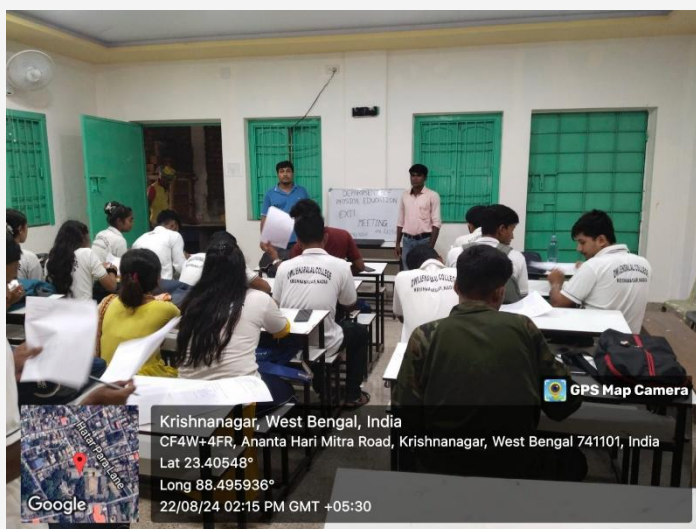

(SAMSKRTASAPTĀA-SAMULLĀSA)**

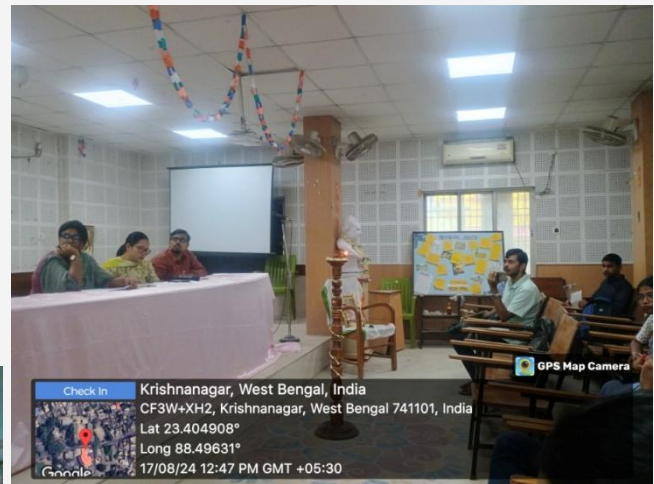


Department of Sanskrit has organized the seven daylong celebrations on Sanskrit Week from 16/8/2024 to 22/8/2024.

## 19TH AUGUST: RAKSHA BANDHAN UDYAPAN



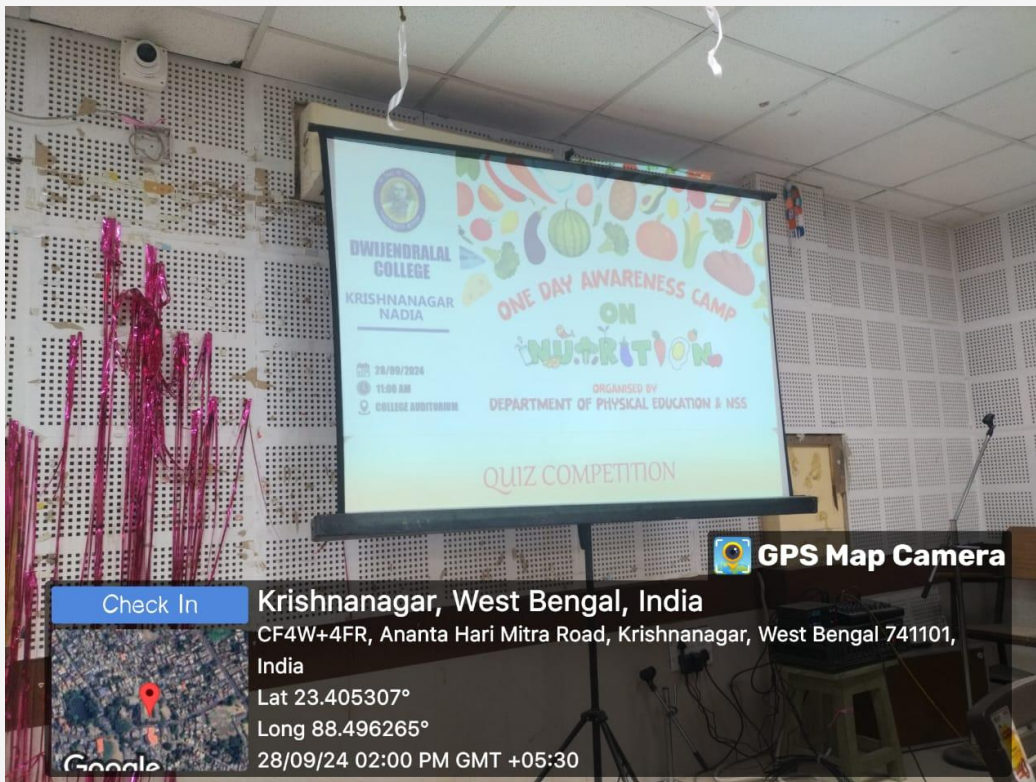
