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OBITUARY

IN LOVING MEMORY OF DR. PARIKSHIT THAKUR

(Reminiscing is a great way for the bereaved ones to make grief bearable.)



Died on January 08, 2024 at an age of 38 years

Dr. Parikshit Thakur was born in Murshidabad on February 28, 1986. He completed his schooling in Ramkrisna Mission Resident School and graduated from Ramkrisna Mission Vidyamadir, Belur. Then he went on to earn his Master Degree in 'International Relation' from Jadavpur University, Kolkata. Thereafter he completed his MPhil in 'Social Sciences' (2008 – 2010) and PhD in 'International Relations and Political Theory' (2012-2019) both also from Jadavpur University. Parikshit joined Raja N. L. Khan Women's college, Medinipur in 2010 and later Dwijendralal College, Krishnanagar in 2016. He had a keen interest in literature, history, mythology at his young age. Even from that young age to the end, the characteristic excellence that had repeatedly impressed his near & dear ones were a strange combination of unfailing simplicity and inflexible courage. He was neither harsh, nor a snobbish. Never did he compromise with what was unjust or immoral. He had a very simple and inquisitive mind, with extraordinary integrity, perseverance and devotion. He used to seek answers to questions in every possible way in a most unassuming manner.

With a career spanning over 14 years, Parikshit taught with unwavering enthusiasm, inspiring generations of students to reach their full potential. Parikshit's impact extended beyond the classroom. He mentored aspiring students & juniors, contributed to many books and actively participated in educational initiatives. His expertise in political science education earned him numerous accolades, including the prestigious presentation of papers in national & international journals. One of those was a chapter titled "Globalization and the Demise of Nation State" in the book Understanding Globalisation published by Routledge, London. He went to London with a prestigious Charles Wallace Fellowship. His devotion & honesty in profession and administrative works in Dwijendralal College made it palpable that the college was very close to his heart.

Parikshit had been a vibrant spirit that always enchanted the colleagues positioned around him. He had an amazing ability to attract the attention of gatherings with his perfect mimicry performed all in a sudden. His infectious smile, kindness and generosity of spirit made him a beloved figure among students and colleagues alike.

Dr. Parikshit Thakur, a visionary educator and devoted mentor, left an indelible mark on the lives of countless students and colleagues. His untimely passing at the age of 38, has sent shockwaves through the educational fraternity. His legacy will continue to inspire and motivate future generations. His dedication, expertise and love for teaching and administrative works will never be fallen into oblivion. Parikshit's warmth, laughter and unwavering love will be deeply missed but forever cherished in our hearts. Commemoration of his lively life and personal anecdotes will always be a source of solace for those left behind.

Dr. Thakur will be survived by his wife, Smt. Kuhu Dey and his sole little daughter, Priyadarshini Thakur. May God give endurance to this bereaved family !





INTERNATIONAL MOTHER LANGUAGE DAY OBSERVATION (21.02.2024):




GIRLS COMMON ROOM:






DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH



2024 at 1pm. in the Department of Philosophy. We have taken the feedback about our Departmental activities, completion of the course and behavior of the teachers in the class from




